Description:

Motor Fresh gives the engine bay of the car a new and tidy appareance.

Benefits:

Application:

Motor Fresh provides a new and tidy appearance under the bonnet. After the engine compartment has been cleaned with Engine Cleaner MV40, Motor Fresh is applied by spraying. Motor Fresh gives the plastic and rubber parts more body and makes the whole engine bay look like new. Motor Fresh can also be used on rubber mats.

Directions for use:

Thoroughly clean the engine compartment with Engine Cleaner MV40 (see TDS Engine Cleaner MV40) before using Motor Fresh. Allow the engine compartment to dry up as much as possible. Then spray the Motor Fresh on all parts of the engine using a pressure pump or a hand sprayer. It is no problem if the engine compartment is still slightly damp from cleaning. Then let it dry for about 20-30 minutes, time depending on the ambient temperature. If necessary, remove excess Motor Fresh with a clean cloth. Shake Motor Fresh well before use.

Tips & tricks:

- Apply Motor Fresh after cleaning and before starting to polish and clean the remaining parts of the exterior. This is due to mist that may come on the paint or windscreen during application. Motor Fresh is also available in a silicone-free version.
- First clean rubber mats with Interior Cleaner or a high-pressure sprayer. As soon as the mats are dry, spray Motor Fresh on the mat. Leave to dry thoroughly and rub with a clean cloth to prevent the mat from becoming slippery when driving the car.
